

## **Llanfechain School**

### **Pupil Development Grant and Early Years Pupil Development Grant**

Our school receives a grant from the Welsh Government to support the development of pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals (eFSM). We aim to assist ALL pupils in aspiring to reach their potential. For this financial year 2020-21 we have been allocated £5750 (PDG) and £1050 (EYPDG) which is coordinated by Mrs Catherine Hart as Headteacher. We plan to use the grant as follows:

- Extra Teaching Support for nurture, interventions, added academic support
- Tracking their progress for effectiveness of input
- Monetary support towards enrichment activities
- Staff Learning
- Purchase ICT devices to support eFSM pupils in their learning

Headteacher to take a strategic lead in improving levels of pupil engagement and to monitor the impact of PDG spending.

### **Accelerated Learning Grant**

Our school has received a grant from the Welsh Government to support vulnerable pupils following the school closure due to Covid-19. We aim to assist our vulnerable learners to regain lost skills and support wellbeing and emotional needs. For this financial year 2020 -2021 we have been allocated £1230 which is co-ordinated by Mrs Catherine Hart as Headteacher. We plan to use the grant as follows:

- Extra Teaching Support for nurture, interventions, added academic support for vulnerable learners impacted by school lockdown

### **Professional Learning Grant**

A total sum of £1330 to develop shared, distributive leadership in the school in regard to developing professional practice in line with the principles of the Curriculum for Wales. Staff to be given time to carry out Action Research, to experience school to school support and time for School Improvement Plan priorities and termly Impact Assessments to ensure the raising and maintaining of standards and wellbeing.

### **Regional Consortia Schools Improvement Grant (formerly Education Improvement Grant)**

Our school receives a grant from the Welsh Government to support the development of the school to improve educational outcomes for all pupils. For this financial year 2020-21 we have been allocated £4,270 which is coordinated by Mrs Catherine Hart as Headteacher. We plan to use the grant as follows:

- Staff training
- Shared staff professional development
- Additional teaching materials
- Tracking pupil progress for effectiveness of input
