Religious Education and Assemblies

The school follows the Powys Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education and an act of Collective Worship, which is of a mainly Christian nature, takes place each day in accordance with 1988 Education Act.

An assembly, including an Act of Collective Worship, involving all children is held three times a week and class assemblies twice a week. It is a time to develop a sense of unity and togetherness for the whole school. Assemblies are organised and led by staff, children, the Vicar and other visitors to school.

Parents have the right to withdraw their children from RE lessons and/or Collective Worship on the grounds of conscience or belief, such requests should be submitted to the school in writing.

The school has close links with the Church in Wales Diocese (St. Asaph, North Wales) and St. Garmon's Church, where services to celebrate Christian festivals are regularly held. We also enjoy regular visits from the Bishop's Visitor and the Impact Schools Team.
